



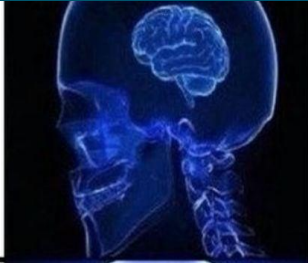

SIGNIFICANCE

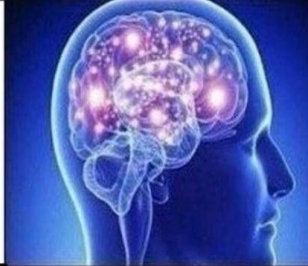
- Dawking's stated that memes are able to transmit information and influence behaviors similar to biological genes.

MEMETIC WARFARE

WHO

Many technological advanced first world countries have implemented the use of memetic warfare (i.e. Taiwan, Russia)

WHAT

Memes are used as a modern tool for propaganda and psychological warfare.

WHEN

Memetic warfare is a relatively new concept enabled by the widespread overuse of social media.

WHERE

- Taiwan installed a memetic engineering to counter pro-Chinese political efforts and disinformation.
- Russia in efforts to annex Crimea deployed bot accounts and troll farms to spread pro-Russian sentiment.

WHY

Memes are able to influence perception, ideas, and behaviors. They're able to communicate a message with ease using emotion and humor.

CONSEQUENCES

The simple and efficient use of memes can be strategically used to reach individuals and communities by extremist groups or foreign state actors in an effort to convey a desired narrative.



SOLUTIONS

Monitor and track extremist/misinformative messaging in memes and inform the viewer using similar methods to fact checking.

Acknowledge how online echo-chambers can influence thoughts and behaviors in yourself and others.
