As she states in the beginning, when you are an entry level cybersecurity analyst, you will probably be in more of a "help desk", responding to incidents. She also says that entry level is providing guidance and training for user awareness. This connects to being a "team player" and "communications" because as someone working at the "help desk" you are going to need to be able to work with the other people around you to figure out if something went wrong or find a hole where something has the potential to go wrong. Communication skills are important when you are providing guidance and working in a team because you need to be able to communicate in an effective way, especially if you are trying to convey a topic that may be hard to understand from someone outside of IT.

I think in the presentation, the biggest social theme that comes across is that social skills are not only required, but expected. There is a slide that talks about recent job ads and how they don't report needed social behaviors, but the social behaviors listed that are needed for cybersecurity professionals are largely behaviors expected of anyone who works. Social behaviors like communications, being a team player, and continued learning are behaviors that are necessary in most fields because in a lot of cases you will be working with other people and need to know how to interact with them in a helpful, professional way. I think the biggest theme is being able to communicate and work with other people, which is demanded.
